Additional Requirements from OSHA Standards:

- advance notification to all Regional Notification Centers and known owners of subsurface facilities at least 2 working days prior
- advance notification to all Regional Notification Centers and known owners at least 2 working days prior
- advise Regional Notification Centers at least 2 working days prior to digging (Cal/OSHA T8 Section 1541(b)(2))

- must be grounded by an equipment grounding conductor which is contained within the same raceway, cable, or cord, or runs with or encloses the circuit conductors
- one cell or battery per outer packaging
